FIRST SESSION

09:20 – 09:25 Anthems of Greece, Rotary & Europe

09:25 - 09:30 Welcome & Introduction and agenda

President Jens Christian Steenvinkel Pedersen welcomes everyone to the first of the three conferences of the year 2016-2017, expresses his happiness that so many CRs present despite all the troubles with the strike and names the agenda for today

09:30 - 09:35 Country call, proxies

The Secretary Fatima Sultygova does the country call and checks the presence of Country Representatives (in the following shortened to CRs) and the previously declared proxies for absent CRs.

The presence list can be seen in the table at the end of the minutes. 33 CRs or their proxies are present, representing 85 district votes.

SECOND SESSION

09:35 – 10:10 Update from the Board (President, Vice-President, Secretary, Treasurer, Social, Marketing, IT Officers)

President

Jens tells CRs about the Strategic Weekend that the Board had in France for networking and forming the goals of the year; thanks Board and CRs for the work done so far; speaks about CR involvement this year and that now the work is divided by 50, not 10 people and therefore will hopefully be done more efficiently

Vice-President

Eugenie tells about the idea to promote the workshops at events better than before to show that events are not solely for parties. So far all the workshops of REM Athens are booked out, and she hopes that people don't have to catch the flights later this afternoon to be able to attend the meetings. She already has some ideas for future workshops but she inspires everyone to give their ideas. Eugenie also announces the coming CR training and what to wait from it and what will be done by her during the year explaining its importance: Rotaract directory, event manual and bylaws change, white-books of the Board positions.

Secretary

Fatima gives an overview on recent developments concerning the approval documents collection and inspires everyone to keep on working on it. Working groups is a great opportunity that everyone should use and take advantage of. One group has already finished its work (Pricing) and the results will be voted on later today. Board and CR Skype meetings are scheduled for the rest of the year, and the minutes are published in the special section of the website so that any CR has an access to it any time. For the next few months, work in groups on event manual and event manual will be continued.

Treasurer

Thierry presents the final budget of the last year and explains that the income part is a bit less than expected because EuCo Milan gathered the 5eur ERIC fee only from the people who had packages with accommodation. He continues with presenting the current year budget project and discusses

the issue with collecting 3eur and 5eur ERIC fees at the events suggesting that he will open an NGO for ERIC in Luxembourg.

Question from CR Netherlands regarding the 900eur for the Strategic Weekend - that didn't happen before. Thierry answers that it was the common decision of the Board to cover some of the travel expenses for this meeting.

Voting for the project of the Budget of year 2016-2017 was done by raising hands: 100% of CRs present in the room approves it.

Social Committee

Alexander presented his team and gave an overview on the work done by the Committee so far. He starts with the explanation on Buy One More project, flyers about which were distributed among CRs. Alex also explains about the procedure of BESP and TCA voting and tells about social projects during the events. He also announces the 3 webinars that will take place throughout the year. Social Committee say they have already started their white-book, and announce some key dates for the year not to miss.

Question from CR Cyprus about the evaluation tool for BESP and TCA. Alexander answered that he is still thinking about it but as any other officer, he is trying to improve the way it was done before. Probably a Google form will be used

Marketing Committee

Sanja talked about merchandise giving thanks to Maria Jose for the design of the hoodies and polos. After she thanked the Marketing workgroup for helping her with the magazine since most of the articles came after the deadline and they still managed to put it together nicely. For the next issue of the magazine she asks everyone to respect the deadline and send articles as soon as something happens, and not in last moment to avoid the hassle. It is planned to print magazines for REM Bratislava. Please send high resolution photos + MS Word document with checked spelling. Regarding promotion of the events Sanja suggests everyone to put the events on the ERIC webpage and share bigger ones after, giving a link to the ERIC calendar, not any other page adding a country and name of the person who've published it.

IT Committee

Bariscan presented the results of his work for the past 3 months: website updates, minutes and Buy One More pages, ERIC map visualization, REM Poznan and REM St.Petersburg infographics.



THIRD SESSION

10:10 - 10:20 Update on REM Bratislava 2017 by Martin Kmety

After seeing the number of people in REM Athens, HOC Bratislava booked a third hotel to increase the possible number of participants. All the 3 hotels are in walking distance from each other and ready to accommodate up to 600 participants

Gala venue has a capacity of 700 people but HOC plans to keep it to 600 participants top to have some dancefloor.

ERIC Agenda was presented as well.

FIFTH SESSION

ERIC Events Pricing

12:00 Pricing proposals presentation

All the HOCs who used to organize an event were saying that currents prices are too low.

Workgroup consisting of Board members and CRs has worked out 5 proposals and 2 amendments on how to improve the situation.

The proposals are:

- Proposal 1a: Free pricing with auditing officer from Board
- Proposal 1b: Free pricing with 100% budget transparency
- Proposal 2: Fixed price for package, no obligations for accommodation.
- Proposal 3: Fixed price for package, obligations to provide accommodation.
- Proposal 4: Tier 1 & tier 2 countries
- Proposal 5: Raise current prices by €30/night.
- Remaining current pricing policy

The document with all the proposals and their details was sent in email to all CRs prior to the meeting.

Some of the proposals need additional adaption of the amendments on package requirements, and therefore could enter into force only starting from the event following the adaption, i.e. if we adopt the required amendments at REM Winter 2017, the Price system will start working since EUCO 2018.

Amendments to be voted for are:

• "For CR's, board, assistants, workshop-facilitators and other guest speakers, the current price limitations stay into force."

Half of the CRs according to the survey done before don't receive any financial support from their districts/countries and they have to be at all the events and work there

 "HOC candidates will be elected two years in advance. This amendment only enters into force, after establishing a transitory regime."

For HOCs to better prepare for the event, get more sponsors etc.

Eugenie has additionally mentioned that before REM Bratislava a workgroup for event manual will be working on deciding the new rules for the event organization.

Annex 2. Chosen ERIC Events Pricing Proposal to be added to the Bylaws.

Proposal #4: tier 1 & tier 2 countries

The original plan of having different prices per countries is too difficult to keep track of and to update. We decide to split countries into tier 1 & tier 2 according to a set of parameters. To the countries of tier 1, the current prices apply, for the countries of tier 2, the prices are raised. To avoid competition between countries of tier 1 and tier 2, REM's and EUCO's are alternated.

Proposed amendment

"Countries of tier 1 are:

Belarus, Ukraine, Kazakhstan, Bosnia & Herzegovina, Turkey, Kosovo, Albania, Latvia, Romania, Poland, F.Y.R.O.M. (Macedonia), Bulgaria, Montenegro, Armenia, Georgia, Moldova, Serbia, Estonia, Lithuania, Andorra, Slovakia, Croatia, Azerbaijan, Czech Republic

Countries of tier 2 are:

Greece, Slovenia, Hungary, Cyprus, Portugal, Germany, Malta, Belgium, Spain, Austria, Finland, Luxembourg, Netherlands, Ireland, Sweden, Norway, Italy, France, UK, Monaco, Denmark, Iceland, Switzerland, Russia

In case there is no candidacy from the tier who's turn it is, two months before the event where the next HOC will be elected, every country can apply.

When HOC's or candidate HOC's have problems achieving the imposed prices, CR's can in all cases vote to allow for deviations. Carte blanche however is not possible, and the request for deviation has to be motivated and documented.

Entrance into force: 1st of January 2018." (These prices apply starting REM winter 2018.)
