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I. ANALYSIS, OPPORTUNITIES AND MAIN IDEA FOR THE PROJECT.

1. ANALYSIS OF THE PROBLEM WE WANT TO SOLVE

Within the village, there is no first aid healthcare structure that can provide primary care to its inhabitants. Therefore, they are forced to reach the hospital in Fatick, which is 30 km away, using the only available means of transportation, represented by donkeys or horses.

2. OPPORTUNITIES

Once the works are completed, they will be managed by the municipality of Patar Sine, which will initiate a selection process for operational personnel, in collaboration with the local Ministry of Health and the Touba association.

The village would be self-sustaining in terms of health, which would allow residents to have a facility for both women giving birth and in extreme emergencies and for vaccinations

II. HOW TO EXECUTE THE PROJECT

1. ACTION GROUP

Project coordinators: oversee the entire project from start to finish;

Accounting manager: management of the funds raised and the expenses to be incurred;

Club contacts: keeps your club in contact with the project coordinators;

Marketing officer: updates social media;

International relations officer: deals with maintaining relations with the municipalities of other nations, clubs of different nations and with various international organizations.

2. DESCRIPTION OF THE PROJECT

This project is aligned with one of the areas of intervention of Rotary International, which is to "increase people's access to modern health facilities, equipment, and programs."

Additionally, the third goal of the UN's 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development is to "ensure free and low-cost healthcare in underdeveloped areas."

3. GOALS OF THE PROJECT

From January to early March, the structure was completed with the roof installation and, by the end of March, the external facade and internal parts (such as plastering and tiling) will also be completed.

In April, electrical and water connections will be made, and the structure will be

completed by the end of April - early May. Once the first aid center is operational, in agreement with local authorities, a doctor will be made available inside the facility to coordinate it along with nursing staff.

The doctor will be sent from the central hospital of Fatick: he had already been assigned to the village, but could not practice before the construction of the facility.

4. TARGET AUDIENCE

All the inhabitants of the village of Mboul Souka will be able to benefit from basic medical care, particularly vaccinations, assistance to pregnant women, and basic care.

5. ACTION PLAN & TIME FRAME

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Brief description of each step

- 1)Construction of the building
- 2)Set up of the clinic
- 3)Management of healthcare personnel
- 4)Availability of medicines and medications

The critical part is that the local government provides only one doctor and not enough nursing staff compared to the number of inhabitants of the village.

6. RESOURCES

To replicate the project it is necessary to collaborate with the local authorities, the associations operating locally and the Rotary and Rotaract Clubs present in the area.

The project was funded entirely by the Rotary Clubs and Rotaract Clubs and also received a District Grant from Rotary District 2101.

7. BUDGET

The estimate for the completion of the property is €8,995.00 and includes expenses relating to the electrical system, labor and building materials.

Prices vary based on currency and purchases and expenses to be incurred.
